

In this project, Mario Bellini took his inspiration from a basic elemental structure in architecture. His design emulated the colonnade of classical architecture, in which a sequence of columns supports a portico, in this case a table top. The base is a visually closed volume, despite being materially open.

When seen from a different viewpoint, perception changes completely, as the columns no longer overlap and the space appears empty.

Maintenance

Clean only with a soft cloth, warm water and pH neutral detergent. Do not use: acids, ammonia, abrasive powders, window cleaners and so on. Any substance with an acid pH will damage marble: lemon juice, wine, etc. Marble is treated with a waterproof sealant to protect it from damp and stains (as long as they are cleaned immediately); however, this sealant naturally wears off over time. We recommend treating the marble with sealant every three months, more frequently in the case of hotel and catering establishments.
