



DUNA | Nomadic liquid motif

Recalling the desert landscape of the Bedouins **DUNA** is firmly part of the Mediterranean family of cultures united by the sun and its intense light, a light that fades, that fascinates and that shimmers in the heat. A geometric motif that is dream like, monochromatic and liquid.

Designed by Odosdesign for **GAN**, **DUNA** is part of the **KILIM collection** of rugs, and inspired by the nomadic way of life and the use of rugs to construct mobile living spaces.

"The idea came about from the combination and superimpositions of layers similar to the ones that are used when creating a watercolour painting. So that different grades of transparencies are mixed together and form a monochromatic grid that almost appears to be three dimensional."

DUNA is available in a choice of three dimensions; 150 x 200 cm, 170 x 240 cm and 200 x 300 cm. Made using the Kilim technique with 100% new wool the rug is reversible, its neutral grey hue easily adaptable to any space.
